interRAI Services works closely with the interRAI Research Network (iRN) to promote the value of interRAI through data and research. Each year, interRAI Services and the iRN present an Emerging Researcher Award to enable its recipient to attend and present their research at the annual interRAI Knowledge Exchange.

Eligibility criteria:

- the recipient must be within 5 years of completing a Ph.D., or currently studying a post-graduate degree
- the recipient must attend the 5th Knowledge Exchange in Wellington on 10 February 2025 to present their research
- the recipient's research utilises interRAI data
- the recipient is prepared to join the iRN
